The talk by Patricia Hersh, discussing her recent paper in Inventiones, on regular cell complexes and total positivity, was a highlight. We were also happy to welcome Mats Boij back as an invited speaker again; one of the founders of Boij-Söderberg theory, and a faculty member at KTH in Stockholm, he has attended the conference several times.
